RULES AND REGULATIONS

No Drug or Alcohol use on or off property. The use of any drugs or alcohol will result in immediate discharge from ***Integrity House***. The use of illegal substances on the property **will** result in legal action. All residents will be drug tested upon entrance and acceptance in the house, and are subject to random drug tests. Any resident taking medications must report his use and dosage of all medications. Residents subscribed to serious narcotic, or narcotic synthetic drugs such as xanax, methadone, or oxycontin will not be allowed residency until they have detoxed from these substances. If a resident is found sharing his prescribed medication with another resident, both residents will be asked to leave the house. Refusal to test will be treated as a positive result.

Zero Tolerance Rules- *while residing at the house, any of the following will result in being asked to leave.*

- **Breaking the Law or arrest**
- **Disrespect toward Staff**
- **Failing a drug test**
- **Allowing anyone who is not an Integrity House resident onto the premises**

***Any visitors must be approved by Staff.**

Curfew is as follows:

1st Mo.-10pm Sun.-Thurs., 12am Fri & Sat.(unless weekly fees are not paid in advance)

2nd Mo.-same as 1st

3rd Mo.-same but Furloughs can be requested.

4th Mo.-12am

*Any Furloughs or exceptions for work schedule must be approved by Director.

Church Attendance:

- Residents are required to attend Integrity Church on Sunday unless otherwise specified.
- Transportation may be available but it is the residents responsibility to confirm availability or make arrangements

**The Integrity House Weekly Meeting on Thursdays at 6PM is Mandatory.
The first week of the month, the meeting will be Tuesday at 6:30pm**

General Rules

1. No weapons or drug paraphernalia are permitted on the Property.
2. No pornographic material of any kind allowed on the property.
3. Use of Profanity is strictly prohibited.
4. Theft of any kind will not be tolerated & prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law.
5. Smoking is prohibited inside the home. A designated outside area will be assigned but we encourage all residents to quit smoking. We will gladly assist in finding help and support efforts to do so.
6. Lights out at 11pm weekdays (Sun-Thu), and 1:00am weekends.
 - No television use after lights out.
7. All residents must remain dressed (shirt & pants/shorts) until bedtime.
8. Personal hygiene must be attended to daily. (All bedding must be washed at least 1x/week)
9. Residents must be working, looking for work between 10am & 3pm, or volunteering daily.
10. Residents are required to attend all scheduled and required events
- 11. All residents will donate 6 hours per month of community service each month- ie. a church, outreach program, etc. Appropriate service projects will be approved by staff.**
12. Residents ensure that their work schedule will not interfere with ***Integrity House*** Schedule, Events, requirements and Spiritual Growth.
13. All Dishes must be immediately washed and dried after eating your meal.
14. **All residents are expected to be out of bed by 8am & and beds made neatly & rooms cleaned daily.** Afternoon naps are allowed. **All unemployed residents will be required to be out of the house between 9 and 3, actively job searching Monday through Friday. If the new resident needs more phone time in the morning to job hunt, exceptions will be made.**

15. If resident loses his job, he will be required to continuously search for work until he is employed, and will be given 2 weeks to find work, at which point he may be asked to leave ***Integrity House***.
16. If resident works a job schedule that is in conflict with the house curfew an exception will be considered. If approved, the resident must be in contact with the director and must submit his schedule weekly, one week ahead of time. In the event there are changes to the schedule, the resident must immediately notify the ***Integrity House*** Director.
17. Residents are not allowed in other resident's rooms unless personally invited by the resident of that room & only when that resident is present.
18. ***Staff will search personal areas if there is reason or cause.***
19. Chore list duties will be assigned to every resident. It is the residents responsibility to complete them in a timely manner. See Chore List for further explanation.
20. Meals should be eaten at the dining area.
21. Court ordered supervision requirements and Probation must be reported to staff. Residents must be in complete compliance at all times.
22. ***If resident receives a monthly income such as SSI or disability, he will be required to render his fee a month in advance on the day he receives his monthly check This includes back fees.***
23. No inappropriate movies on any of the televisions in the house. This includes nudity, profanity or excessive violence. Please be respectful to your roommates. If the movie or TV show is inappropriate, you may be asked to turn it off.
24. ***The Director reserves the right to dismiss a resident at any time if one of our zero tolerance rules are broken.***

THE HEART OF INTEGRITY HOUSE

At Integrity House our primary focus and goal is the spiritual development of the resident. Our purpose is to habitually disciple our residents to seek God first and to trust in and live according to the spiritual principles found in His Word.

Our recovery perspective is one of practicality. We desire to keep things simple, not debating on doctrines but simply introducing freedom through spiritual principles that carry power and promise.

Some of our residents may not come from a drug and alcohol background or understand recovery principles. Therefore our focus on recovery is not exclusive to drugs and alcohol and we believe that the whole world is in a state of recovery, separated from God, and spiritually bankrupt to some degree.

The house's first priority is to offer an atmosphere conducive to personal recovery and spiritual growth, and we will do all that is necessary to protect the sanctity of the home and the safety of the other residents. We understand the seriousness of the sinful nature of a man and are interested in making the man "whole" not just bringing temporal relief to the pain of his circumstances or environment.

We are a family of spiritual brothers, with purpose in mind: to overcome, succeed, and prosper through the Word of God and the fullness of His spiritual principles.

Ultimately, we will measure our success by the spiritual development and transformation of the resident. INTEGRITY HOUSE is a mission first and foremost and not a business. In our house - deliverance, healing, restoration and reconciliation with God is our first priority, and all other concerns will be secondary.

We will use sound judgment in our relationships with our residents, and will make decisions based on biblical principles. We will stand patiently and steadfastly with integrity and compassion concerning all conflicts.

It is our desire that everyone in our home treats their fellow brothers with love and respect, always keeping an open-mind and remaining teachable. Just like the rooms of recovery we have no interest in controversies, arguments or any belief, philosophy, or discipline that would divert us from our primary purpose - to help the sick and suffering.

Integrity House believes in the 12 step process and recognizes the rooms of recovery as a powerful fellowship and proven lifestyle that has helped millions recover and grow spiritually. We believe that the program lifestyle can complement and improve the recovery of the resident, and is viewed as an asset, not a liability.

Lastly, the goal of our home is not to simply keep our residents clean and sober, but to empower them in every area of their lives. We believe that sobriety is a good start, yet we are called to prosper, succeed, and overcome in every area of life. We love you & thank you for the opportunity to serve you.

INTEGRITY HOUSE WAIVER
